You can access the PCHS Overdrive eBooks from the Overdrive Media Console 3 app (it's free!). Scan one of the QR codes to the right to download the app onto your device (or search your app store for Overdrive).

The PCHS Library now offers a wide variety of eBooks (fiction and non-fiction) to enjoy from your computer, tablet, phone, Kindle, and other devices through Overdrive. You can read these eBooks on your IOS or Android devices through the Overdrive Media Console 3.



#### **TO BORROW eBOOKS WITH ONE CLICK:**

If you are using a tablet or a smartphone, use the app's "Add a Library" (or Get Books) feature to find and save our library's Overdrive website: <http://portcharlotte.lib.overdrive.com>. Search the catalog and once you find an eBook to borrow on the site, click Borrow and enter your **login information (your 8-digit student ID)**.

#### **READ IN YOUR BROWSER ON YOUR COMPUTER:**

You can read Overdrive eBooks on your computer/laptop by using OverDrive Read (if available). OverDrive Read lets you read eBooks right in your browser – no extra software or login required. Simply click Read next to a borrowed eBook to begin reading. For more information, visit <http://readinfo.overdrive.com>.

#### **DOWNLOAD OTHER FORMATS TO YOUR COMPUTER, TABLET, OR SMARTPHONE:**

You will also see download options the library's website next to each of your borrowed eBooks:

- On tablets or smartphones: Use Overdrive's free mobile app to download EPUB eBooks\*\* directly to your tablet or smartphone.
- On Windows or Mac: Use free Adobe® Digital Editions (ADE) software to download EPUB or PDF eBooks to your computer and transfer them to supported eBook readers\*\*. (Download software at [www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions](http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions).)
- On Windows 8 or RT: Use Overdrive Media Console (OMC) for Windows 8 to download EPUB eBooks\*\*.
- For Kindle Books: Select Kindle and you'll be taken to Amazon's website to complete download.

#### **\*\*WHAT IS AN ADOBE ID AND HOW DO I GET ONE?**

An Adobe ID allows you to read Adobe EPUB eBooks in the app and to transfer eBooks from your computer to supported eBook readers. Follow the one-time prompt on your computer or device to create a free Adobe ID and complete authorization.
